Athens County Overview

Demographics:

- Athens County is located in southeast, Ohio.
- Population of 65,945
- 45 minute drive-time population of just under 600,000.
- Ohio University is the county's "economic engine" and employs over 500 people.
- Other major industries: healthcare and retail and accommodation/food services given the presence of the university.
- Cost of living is 11.8% lower that US average

Athens County Economic Development Council

- The Athens County Economic Development Council (ACEDC) works to diversify Athens' economy and prioritizes business retention and attraction in the advanced manufacturing, biotechnology, bio health and agritechnology sectors.
- The Athens County Port Authority is run through the ACEDC and leads site development and remediation efforts for the county.

- Downtown redevelopment of historic Armory building into shared works spaces and event space
- Funded through the Appalachian Community Grant program and part of regional strategy
