



### Future scenario matrix explored plausible futures out to year 2035










Preferred Future

X axis is Industry Development Y axis is Community Direction





### SCENARIO B: UNIFIED LORAIN COUNTY

The 'Unified Lorain County' scenario conveys a collaborative future with a strong regional community approach that welcomes emerging and future-orientated industry.

#### SCENARIO SNAPSHOT

- Embracing emerging industries through building on to existing traditional industries.
- Strong environmental focus
- Future ready Community Direction with intentional investment in youth, workforce, and resident education
- Diverse community with elevated amenities including transportation, safe and affordable housing, and education
- Significant change in this scenario, which might bring challenges and tensions



- These Focus Group topics made up the STRATEGIC PILLARS for the Lorain County Strategic Action Plan.








