County ballot issues are displayed on three tables: Table A shows property tax levies ballot issues, Table B shows county sales tax and excise levies, Table C shows transit authority (multi-county) sales tax levies, and Table D shows charter county charter amendments.

The "mills" column in Table A displays the total mills the levy will represent if passed; for levies that have "...and Increase/Decrease," the effect of the modification is included.

Issues that have a final margin of less than 0.5% are marked with an asterisk as they may change between now and when results are finalized.
