As Passed by the House

_____ moved to amend as follows:

After line 120097, insert:

"(9) Notwithstanding any other division of this section to the
contrary, the board of county commissioners of a county with a population
under one hundred thousand and annual receipts from one or more taxes
levied pursuant to this section in excess of five hundred thousand dollars
may, by resolution adopted by a majority of the members of the board,
amend a resolution levying a tax under division (A) (1) of this section to
provide that one-third or more of the revenue from the tax, except the
portion required to be returned to townships and municipal corporations
under that division, be contributed to the convention and visitors' bureau
operating within the county and the remaining funds be used by the board
to fund public safety services, economic development, and public
infrastructure improvements in an area of the county that is or has been
impacted by tourism."
