Hocking County Lodging Tax: History, Process, and Impact!

- 1967: Lodging Tax began for OH municipalities and townships
- 1984: Hocking County begins at 3%
- In 2001, Ohio House Bill 94 is passed which allows counties, cities, townships and villages to begin collecting Lodging Tax from establishments with fewer than five rooms.
- Some OH counties have yet to adopt HB 94 missing out on revenue.




Hocking Co. Lodging Tax Office begins!


- The Hocking Co. Lodging Tax office was created January 1st, 2016.
- Most Lodging Taxes are collected through their county Auditor's offices.

How Lodging Tax Works




- 6% total: 3% county / 3% township
- Paid by guests, remitted by the operators.
- Monthly reporting cycle










Lodging Growth










- My first report to the Commissioner's in July 2016
 293 businesses
 1,049 units
- Most recent Commissioner's report July 2025
 620 businesses
 2,176 units
- On average I'm registering 8-10 new lodging businesses each month.







Fancy Figures Cont.



- During Covid Lodging Tax didn't crash it skyrocketed. After a brief closure from the Health Department, bookings surged.
- From 2016 –2020 Lodging Tax gross figures rose roughly \$100k a year.
- From 2020 to year end 2021 those numbers rose from \$1.55M to \$2.32M a \$767, 000 jump. The largest annual increase to date.

Where the Money Goes



- Per the ORC: County Lodging Tax must go to your county's convention center or tourism bureau.
- 95% Hocking Hills tourism Assoc.
- 5% Lodging Tax office operations
- Once regulations for Lodging Tax are adopted by townships it can be used for roads, infrastructure, etc.

The Future of Lodging Tax Compliance



 In 2023 the Hocking Co. Commissioners enacted a new set of regulations with updates to Lodging Tax.



• Certain fees are now taxable along with the room rate.



Registration numbers posted on their online listings.



Compliance software used to track online listings.



A step-by-step plan is in place to collect on back taxes due.
