Capital reappropriations bill, including SNAP administrative funding, signed by Governor

[House Bill 730](#), the biennial capital reappropriations bill which includes an additional \$10 million in SNAP administrative funding for counties, was signed by Governor DeWine on Tuesday.

The key component of the bill for counties is the \$10 million for SNAP administration. The need for this additional funding comes following the passage of the One Big Beautiful Bill Act, which will decrease the federal share of SNAP administrative costs from 50% to 25% beginning October 1, 2026.

The estimated county loss in SFY 2027 is \$38 million. The \$10 million state appropriation, and the \$2.5 million federal match, will assist counties in filling this budget hole.

The funding will be distributed to all county JFS agencies. The legislature estimates that each agency will receive either \$226,486 or the amount equal to their full loss, whichever is less. [This table](#) shows the estimated amount each county JFS will receive, including federal match.

CCAO will work with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services to learn about the timeline for distribution of the funds. General fund appropriations are effective immediately upon signature of the governor.

CCAO testified as a proponent of the bill in both the House and Senate.
