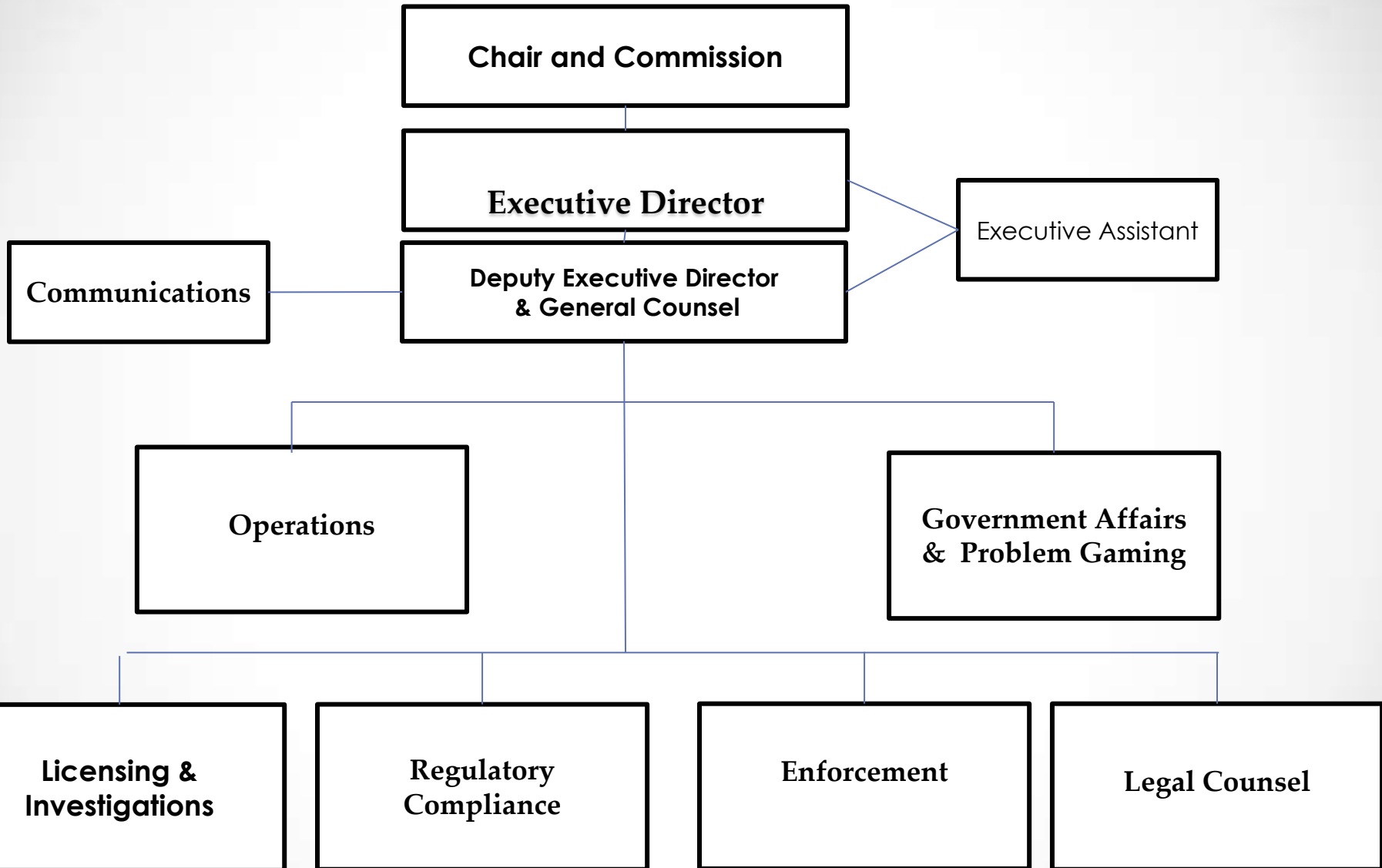

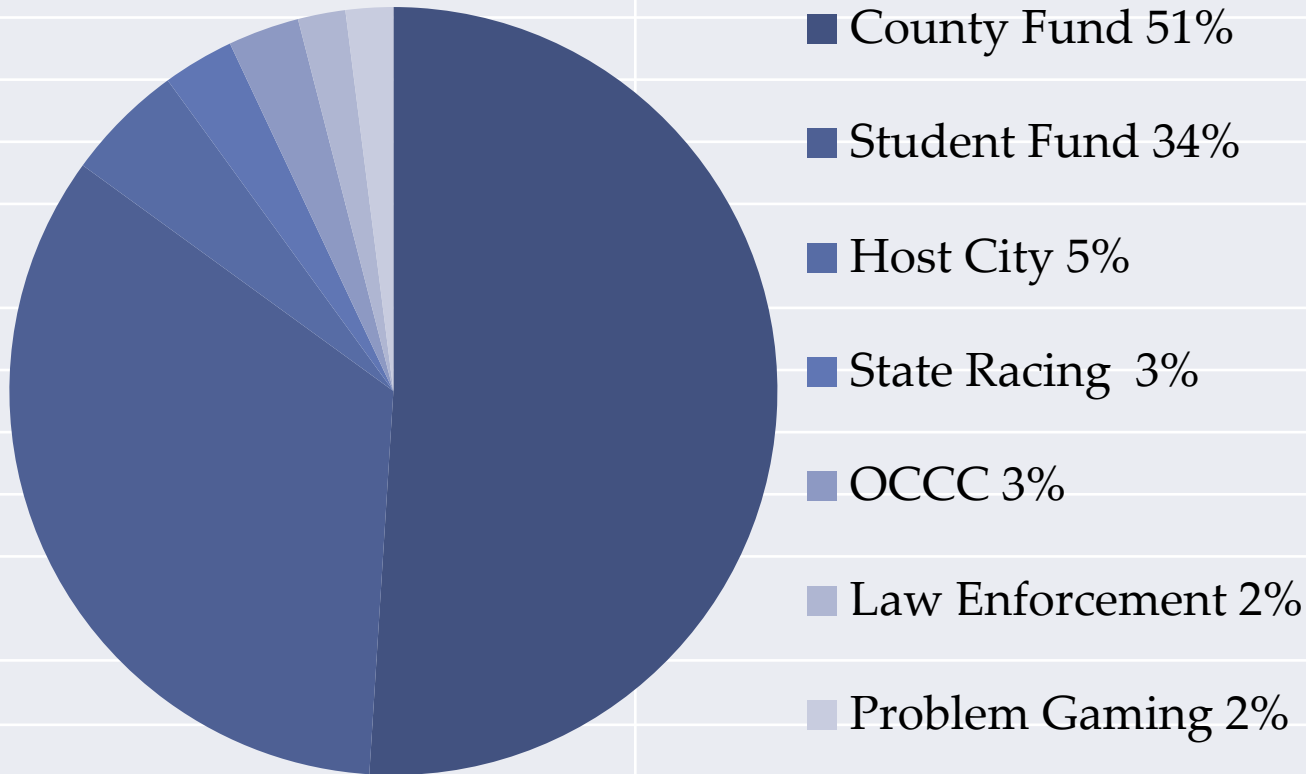

Enforcement

- The Commission is a law enforcement agency.
- Gaming agents enforce gaming laws in the casinos and have arrest authority.
- Gaming agents conduct surveillance.
- The Enforcement Division works with local jurisdictions to prosecute gaming crimes.
- Analysts track casino related crimes.

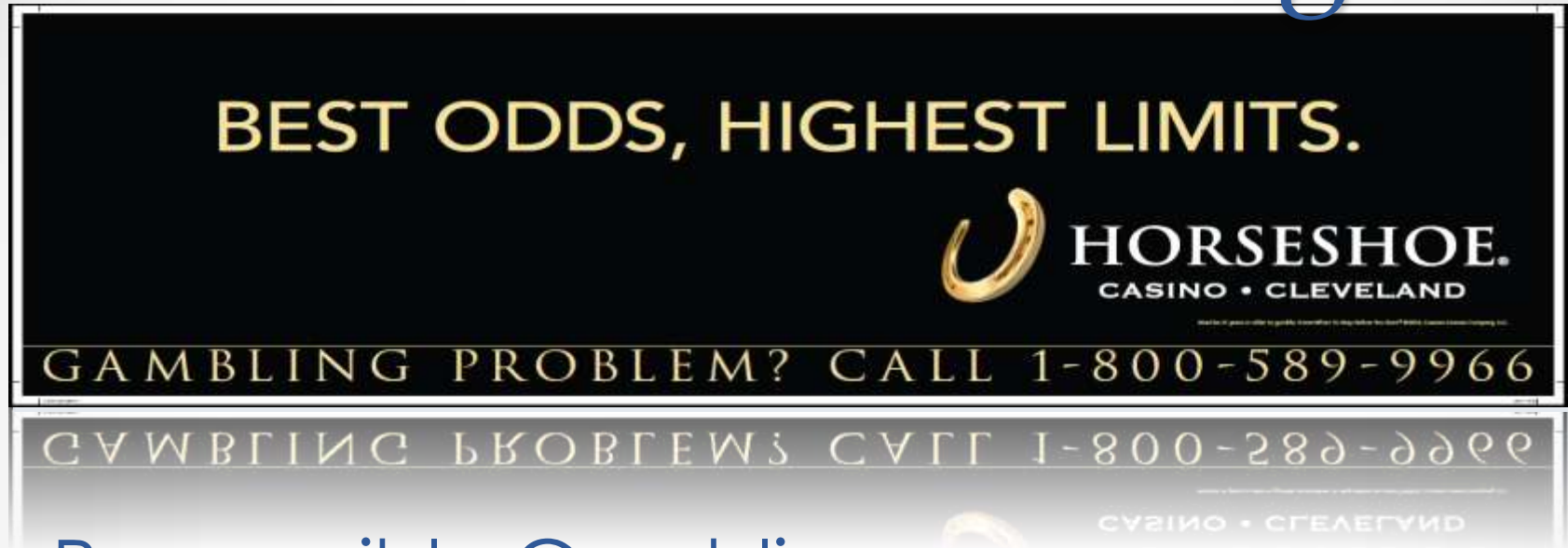
