Construction Contract Reform - Webinar

CCAO is pleased to offer a one-hour webinar on May 8, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. explaining some of the key changes that have been made to Ohio's public improvement law that provide county officials with new options for designing and constructing public improvements. The last state budget amended Ohio's public improvement law to authorize county officials to use single prime contracting, construction manager at risk and design build as alternatives to multiple prime contracting which had generally been required of public owners since 1877.

This webinar will include an explanation of the requirements for contracting with design professionals as well as information on the options now available to counties for constructing public improvements.
