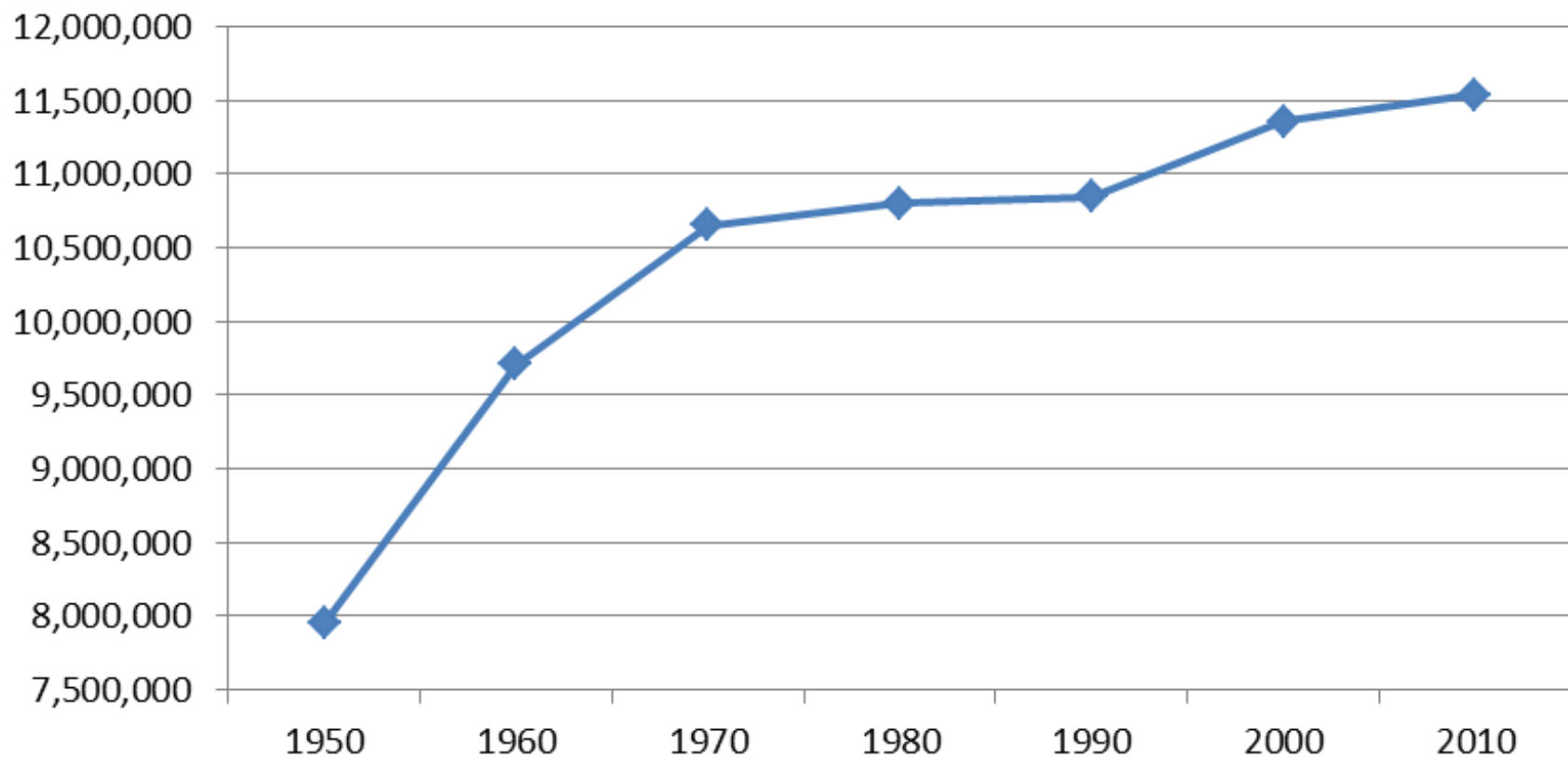

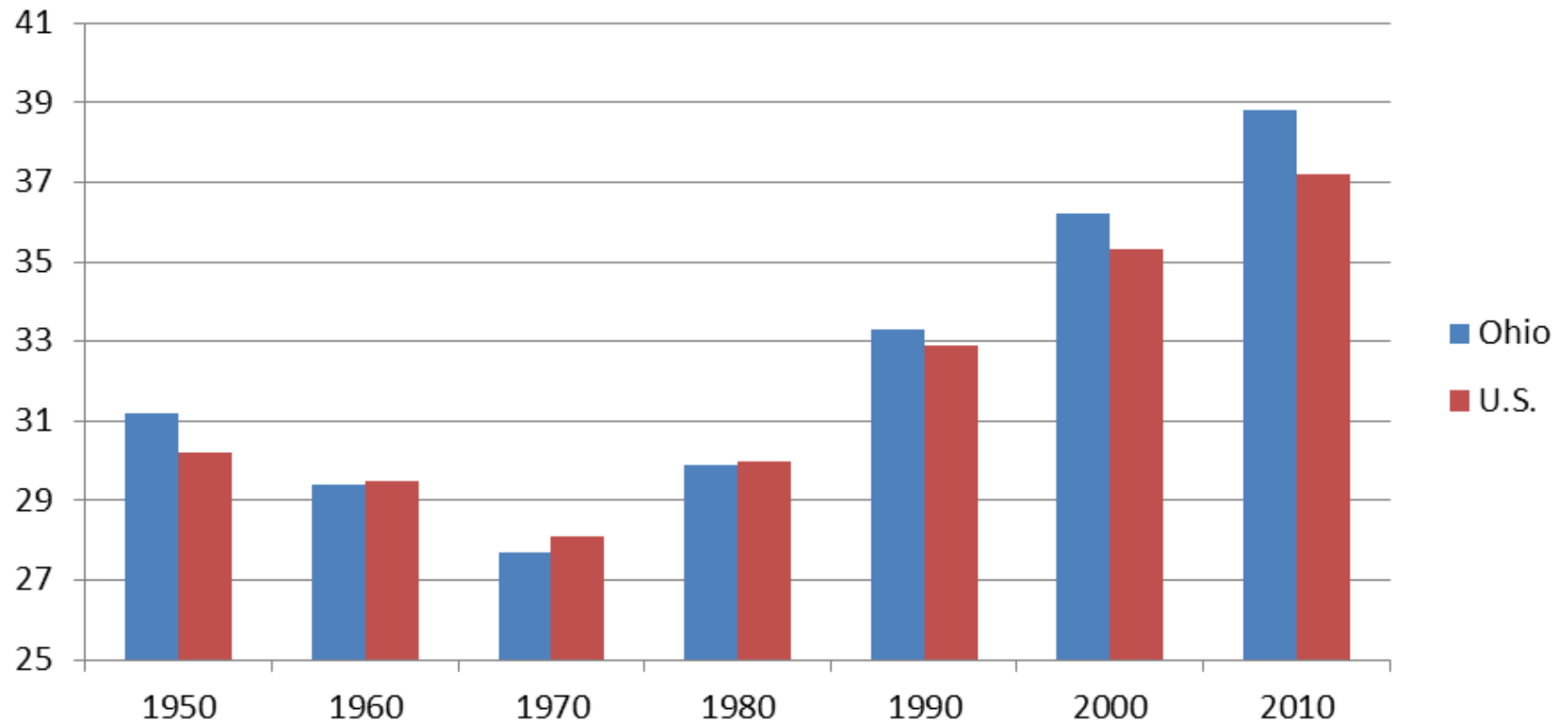

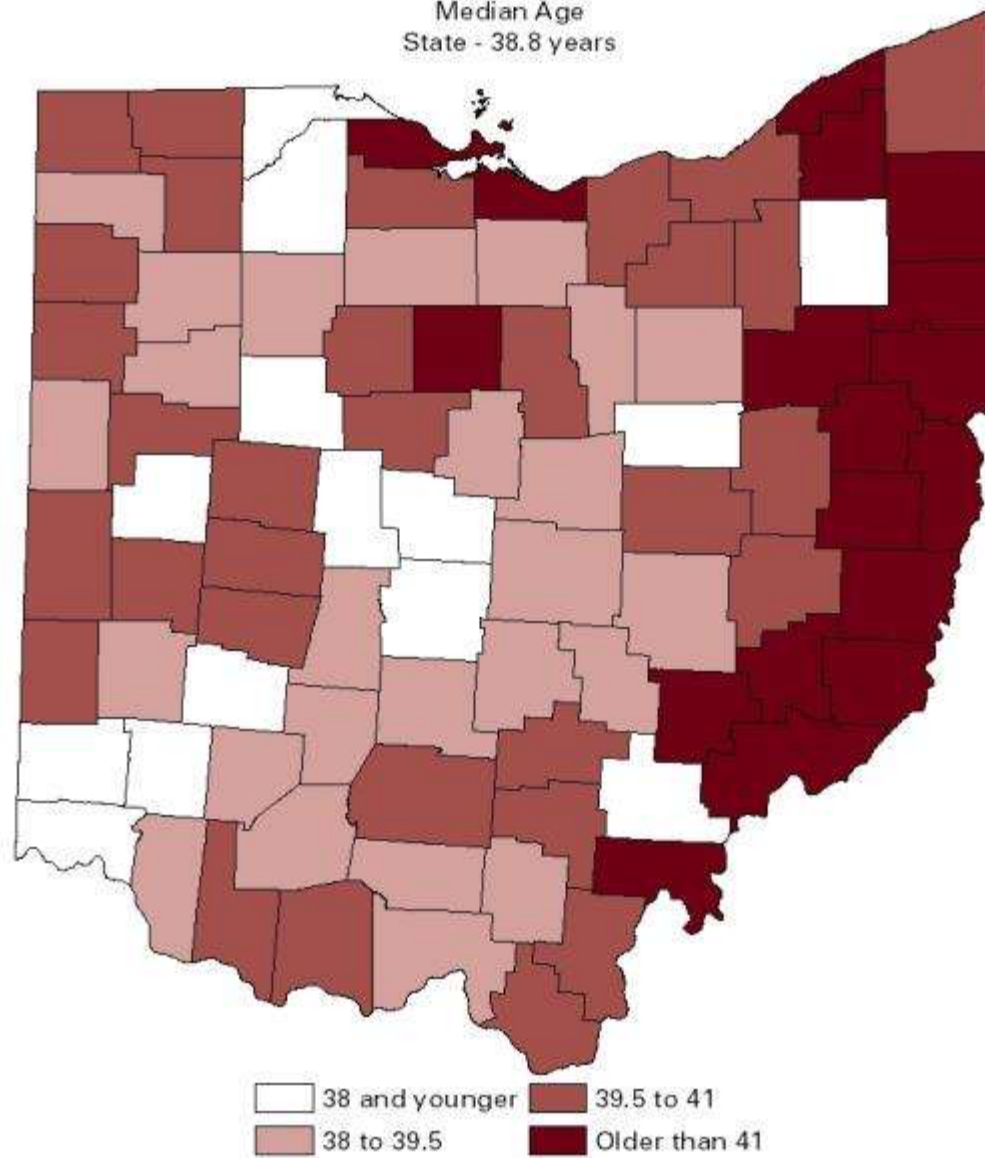
Ohio Population Path 1950-2010

State - 38.8 years

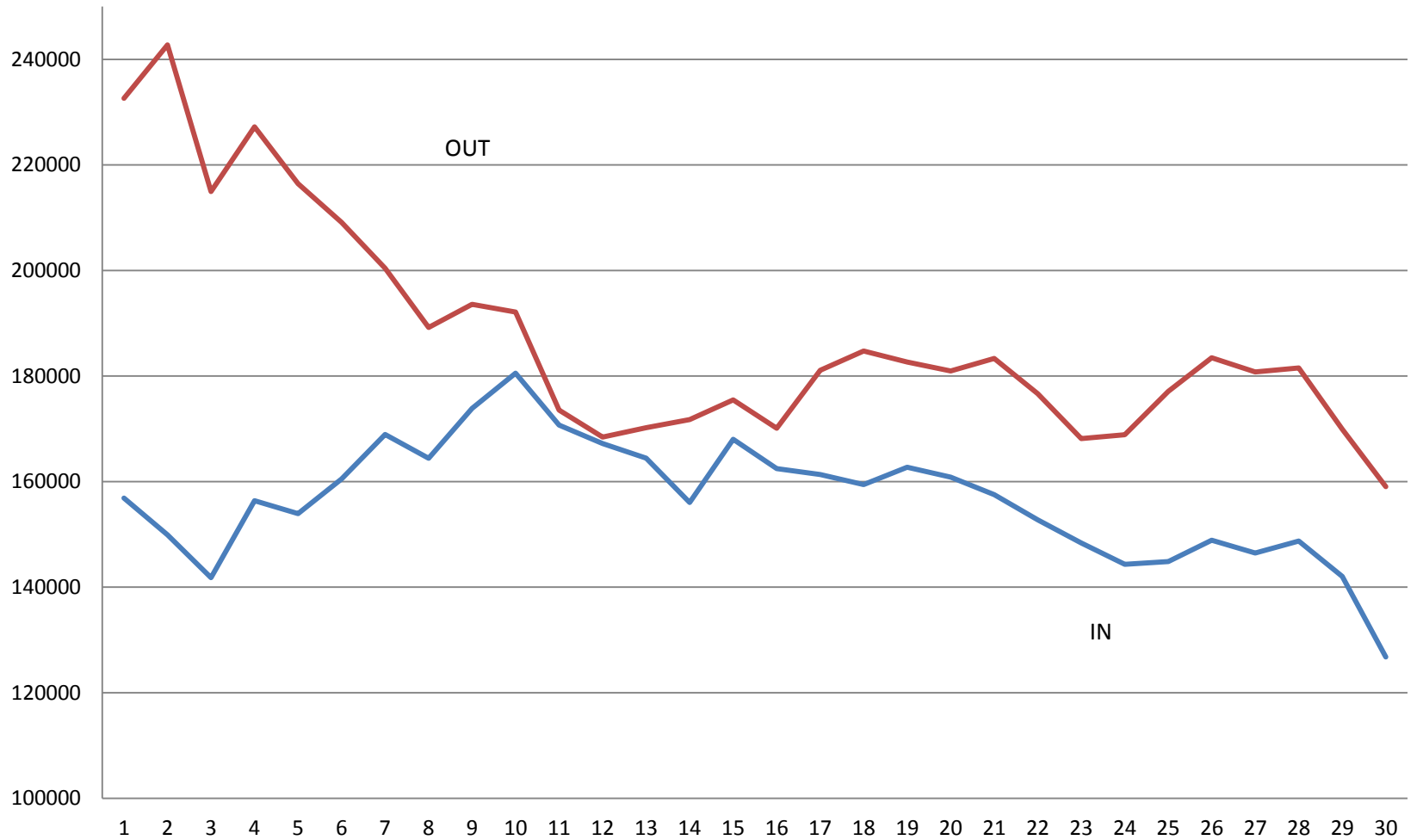

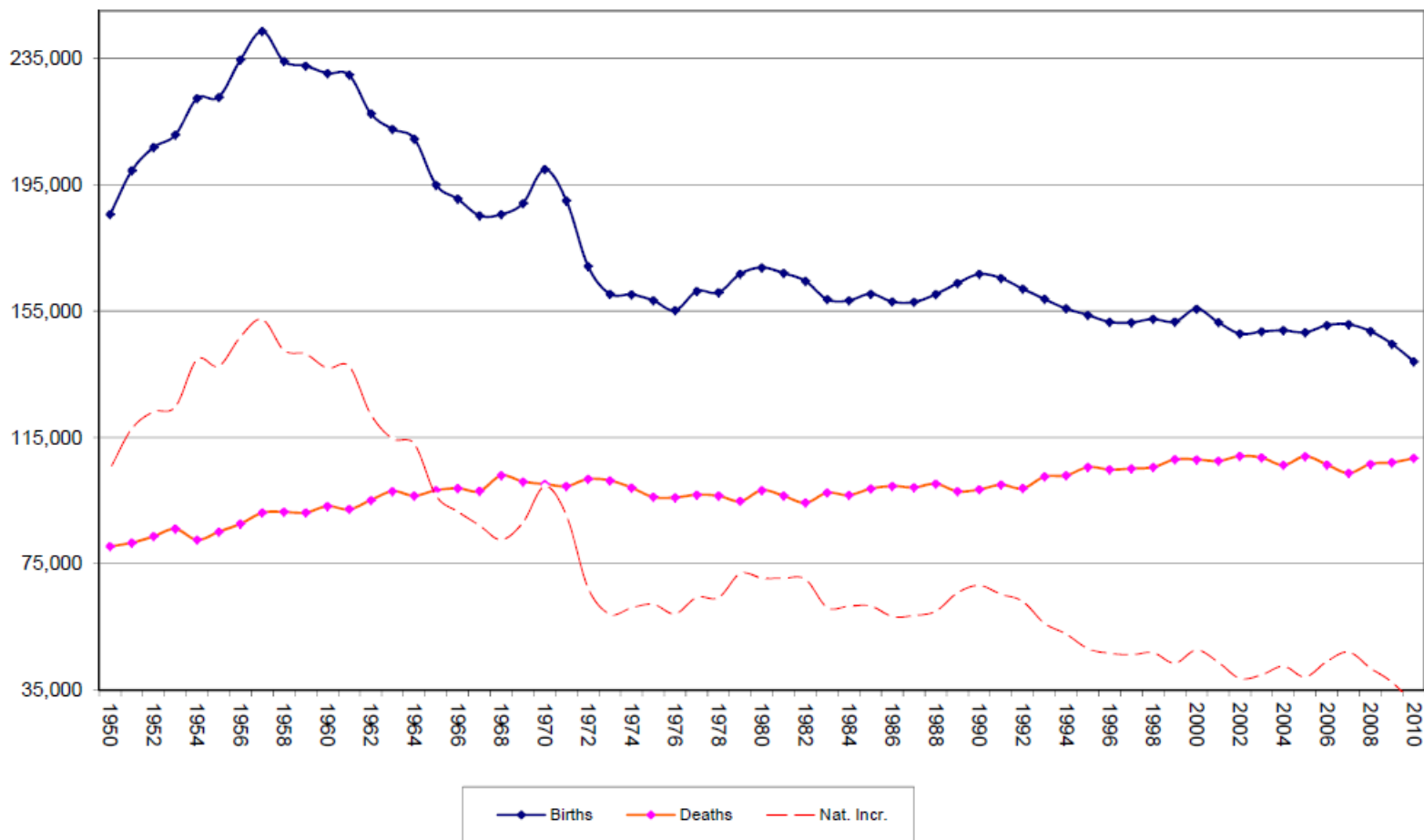

Ohio Migration Patterns 1980 - 2010

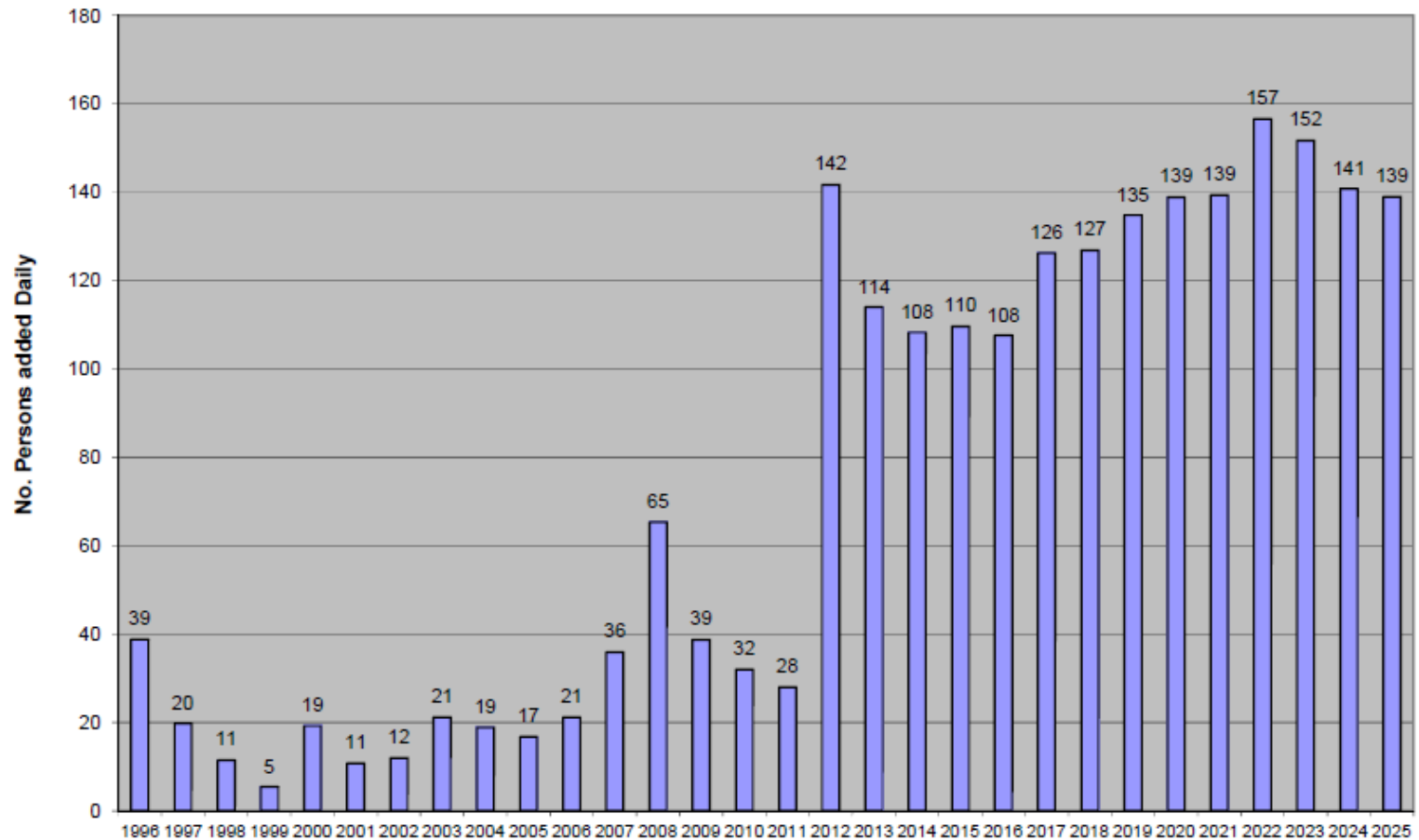


Births, Deaths, and Natural Increase*: Ohio, 1950-2010

* Natural Increase = Births minus Deaths



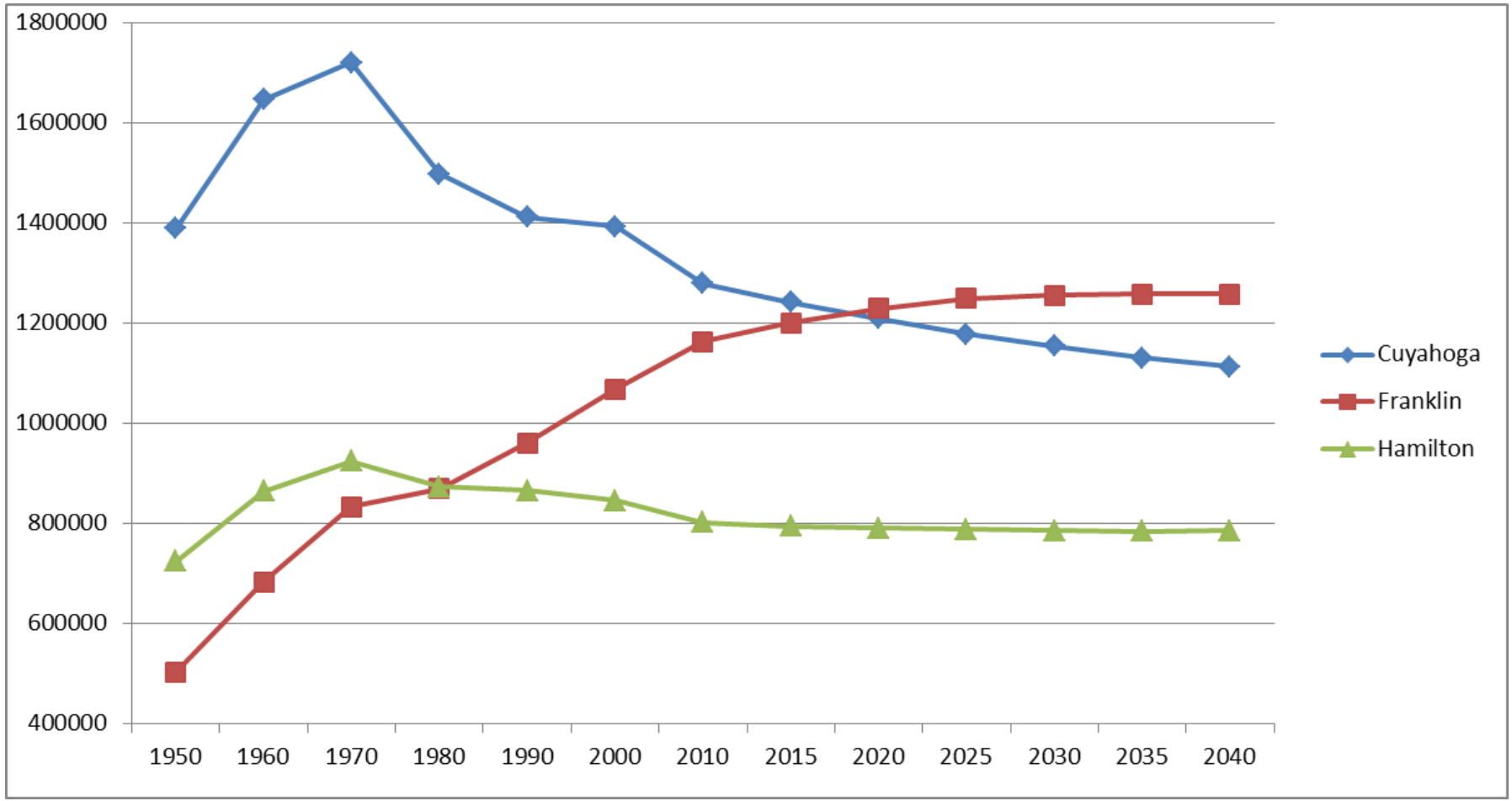
Estimated and Projected Average Annual Net Growth of the 65 and Over Population in Ohio: 1995-2025



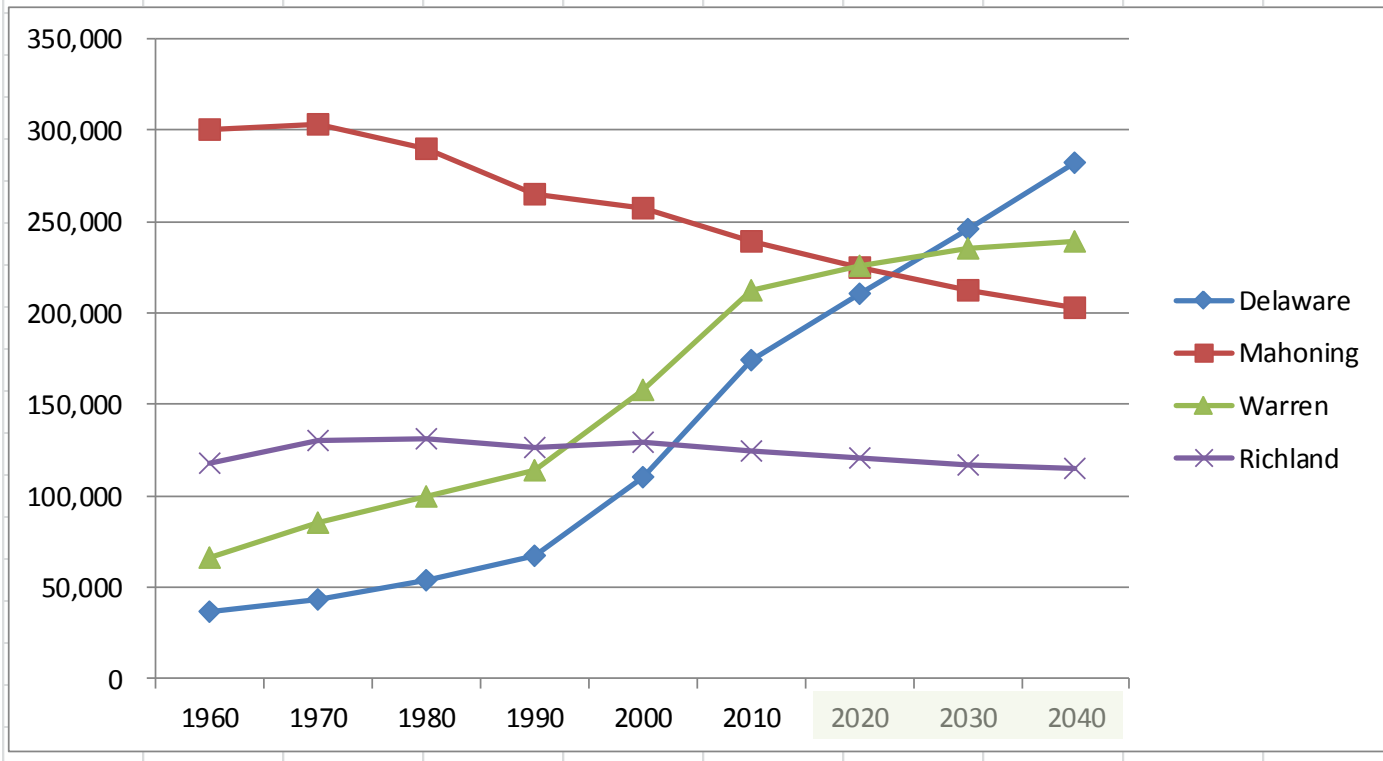

These maps indicate the time periods during which Ohio counties experience negative natural increase, that is, when they have fewer births than deaths. Birth/death ratios were extrapolated using the change in the birth/death ratio from 2000 to 2010. Use of another base time period for trend determination could produce different results.

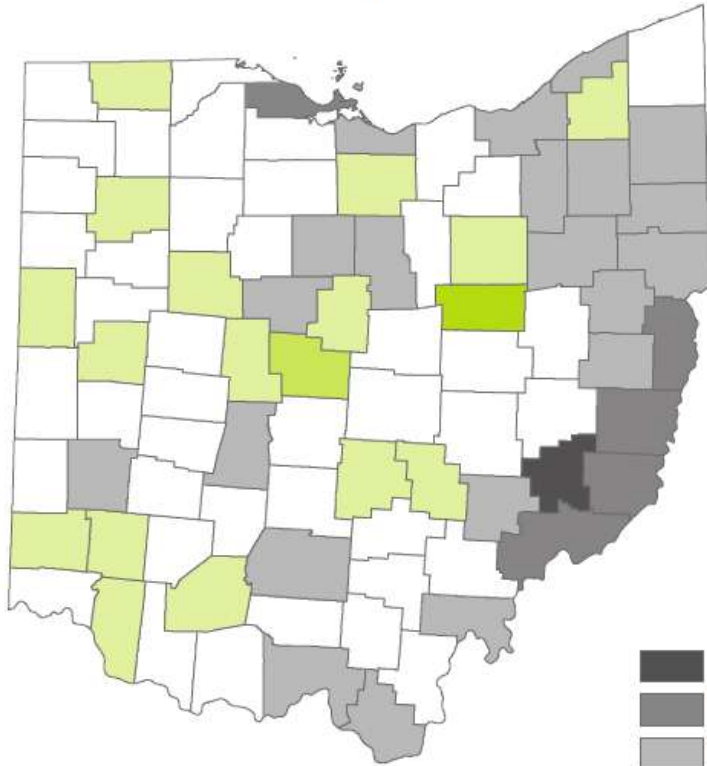

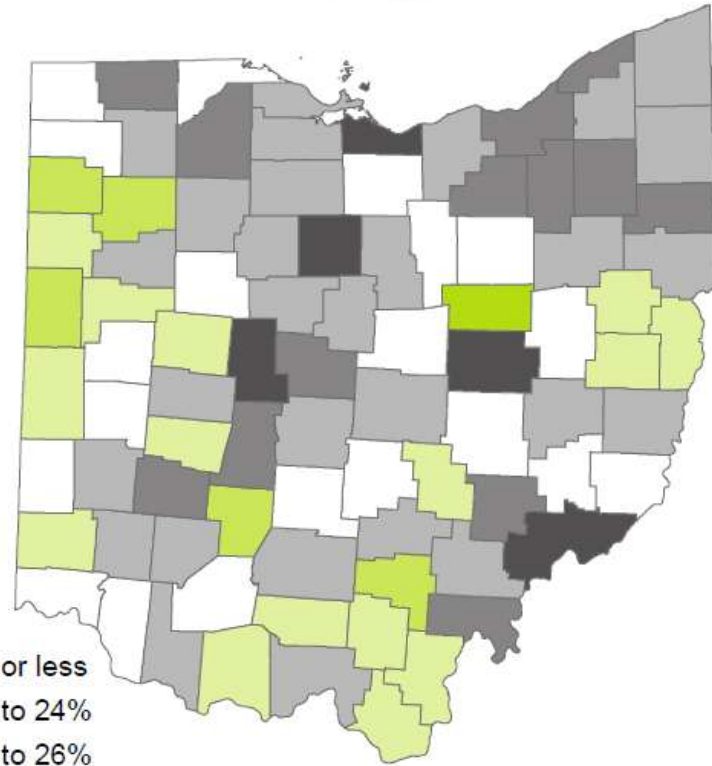

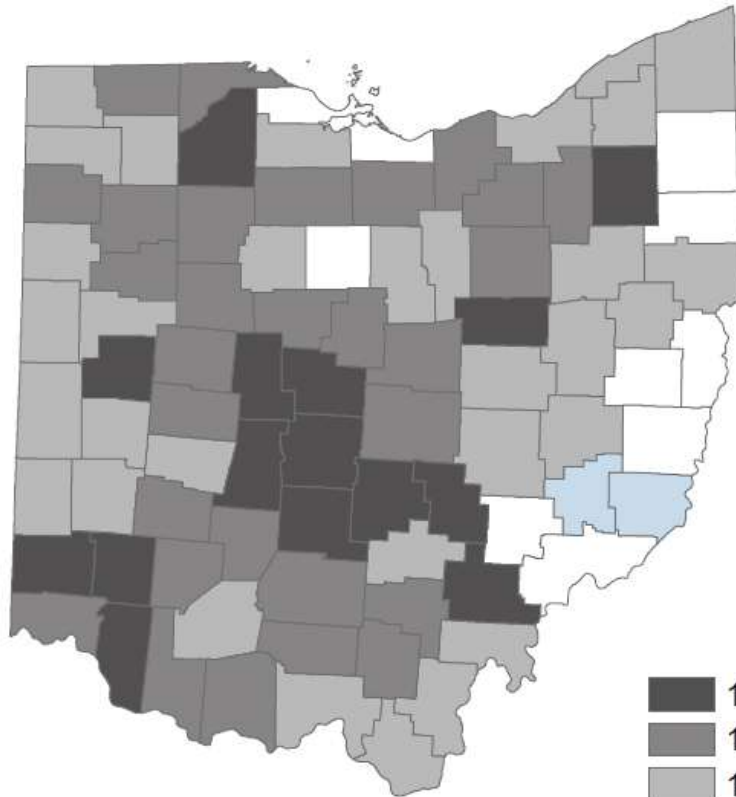

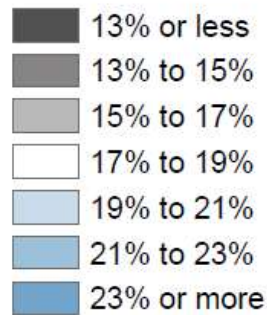
