Steve Grossman, Executive Director of OWDA, who has spent the past 25 years as director overseeing financing to local governments for projects related to water pollution control, water supplies, solid waste and brownfield remediation. Grossman will discuss some of the other public programs that are available to assist local governments with water pollution control and water supply projects.
